

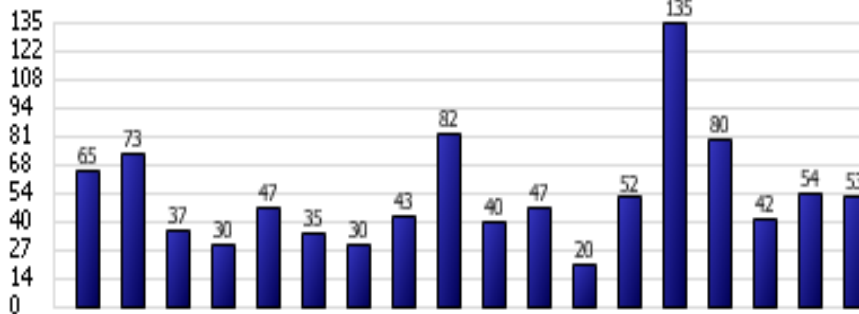
## Forces: U.S. & Coalition/Casualties

There have been 1,095 coalition forces deaths: 964 Americans, 65 Britons, six Bulgarians, one Dane, two Dutch, one Estonian, one Hungarian, 19 Italians, one Latvian, 10 Poles, one Salvadoran, three Slovaks, 11 Spaniards, two Thai and eight Ukrainians, in the war in Iraq. At least 6,497 U.S. troops have been wounded in action, according to the Pentagon
